Fury over 'cruel' BBC gameshow offering jobs as prizes

THE BBC was under fire last night after being accused of turning youth unemployment into a reality TV gameshow.

Desperate jobseekers will be put through tough work placements in Up For Hire and then grilled by bosses before discovering if they have been hired live on air.

However, employment experts blasted the BBC for exploiting such a sensitive issue for entertainment purposes as figures showed that 20,000 university students failed to find work after graduating in 2010.

Tanya de Grunwald, founder of the respected job-hunting website GraduateFog.co.uk, told the Sunday Express: "This show feels inappropriate and cruel."

"It has been designed by someone who has no empathy for how it feels to be young and unemployed in 2011. Turning their struggle into entertainment for a TV audience seems crass and humiliating."
